	 Volunteers will be sent a copy of this risk assessment and guidance reviewed periodically.
Virus transmission due to use of toilets	 Toilets must be open for public health reasons but require heightened signage and cleaning regime. Face coverings encouraged when parishioners are inside.
	 Parishioners advised that children should be accompanied and parents will be asked to wipe down surfaces after use – cleaning materials will be provided to do this.
Unable to support 'Track and trace'	
processes if required due to no	
record of attendance	 All attendees are expected to have come from Mass and will have had the option to use the track/trace process when arriving.
	 Any people arriving post-Mass will be referred to the church's track/track facilities in the porch/narthex.
Difficulty managing social distancing	
with young children	 Families to be asked to keep children near them if possible.
